Peter Lee was asked about CAFOD's work in development and it's response to crises such as famine.

CAFOD's approach is to work with local partners before, during and after a crisis. Each country is the subject of a 3 – 5 year plan and commitment. One result can be seen in the Kenyan village of Kitui, a village in an area often affected badly by drought. Currently, in Kitui, water is available in the dams you have helped to build, and crops are more drought -resilient. This means people have food and fewer people are malnourished.

The approach is one of helping people to solve the problems of today to eliminate the problems of tomorrow. Your generous donations of £352.30 and £239 in the last two weeks go a long way to supporting such work.
